- Mushroom Leadership

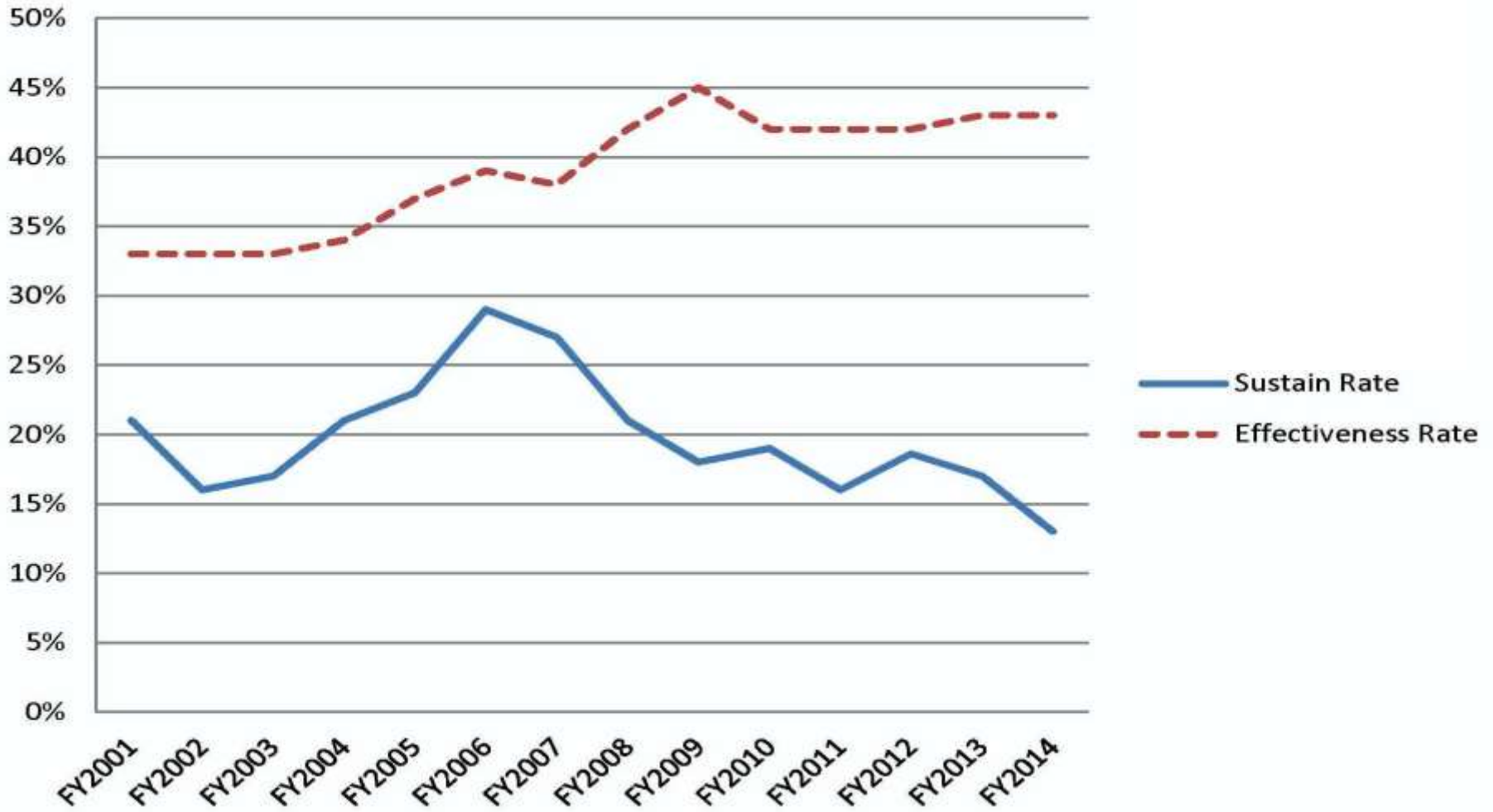
- Democratically immature
